What kind of life are you living? I know that we all have similar aspects to our life. We have family, friends, jobs, school, recreation, and a host of other activity, event based things we are involved in. Some are involved in art. Some are involved in theater. Some are involved in sports. Some are involved in academics. Some are involved physical fitness. I could continue to list multiple things.

But let me ask the question again. What kind of life are you living?

In Ephesians 4 Paul writes these words. *“As a prisoner for the Lord, then, I urge you to live a life worthy of the calling you have received.”* What exactly does that mean? How does that play out in our lives? In the last 8 verses of chapter 3 he lists some things he is praying for the people in Ephesus experience:

- Power of the Spirit
- Depth, width, length, and height of Christ’s love
- Being filled with the fullness of God.

He then writes that God can do immeasurably more than we can ask or imagine through his power that works in us. Get that – **His power that works in us.**

We have been called in Christ to live life with the power of God in us. That means we can live beyond our self-imposed limitations. We have power that is out of this world. We should:

- Be completely humble and gentle;
- Be patient, bearing with one another in love;
- Keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace.
